Beaches & Parks

With an abundance of beaches and parks nearby, you'll never run out of beautiful spots to bask in the South Florida sun.

Enjoy early-morning strolls along the sandy shores, find tranquility floating in the crystal-clear waters, or snorkel to discover the beauty of local marine life.

CURRIE PARK*2400 N Flagler Dr, West Palm Beach*

Slated to reopen in 2024 after an extensive renovation, Currie Park is a waterfront park complete with docks, so you can boat here for a day under the South Florida sun. With tennis courts, greenways, dining options, public pools, a playground, and more, this park is a destination for outdoor enthusiasts.

JOHN D. MACARTHUR BEACH STATE PARK*10900 Jack Nicklaus Dr, North Palm Beach*

With a reef right at the water's edge, the almost two-mile-long beach here is one of those rare spots where you can find great snorkeling just a short swim from shore. Last time, we spotted loggerhead and green turtles, along with schools of brightly colored tropical fish.

LAKE TRAIL*Begins at South Lake Dr near Peruvian Ave North, Palm Beach*

The Lake Trail is a beautifully maintained spot for a jog, leisurely stroll, or bike ride. Spanning five-and-a-half miles, this path surrounds you with beautiful views. Lake Worth Lagoon flows along one side and the West Palm Beach skyline soars above you on the other.

TOWN OF PALM BEACH MUNICIPAL BEACH*Just north of Worth Ave, 300 Block of South Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach*

Easy Sunday mornings mean brunch with friends, followed by a stroll along the soft, sandy shores of pristine "midtown beach." We're always surprised by its tranquility—especially considering its proximity to Worth Avenue.

BATH & TENNIS CLUB*1170 S Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach*

Among the oldest social clubs in Palm Beach, Bath & Tennis Club was founded in 1926 as a private space for influential individuals to dine, swim, and play tennis with one another. Today, it remains one of the most exclusive clubs in town.

MAR-A-LAGO CLUB*1100 S Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach*

Mar-a-Lago means “ocean to lake,” and that’s exactly what this club is—a sprawling mansion set on 20 acres of manicured lawns, with the Atlantic on one side and Lake Worth on the other. It’s also the only private club to attain a 6-Star Diamond Award from the American Academy of Hospitality Sciences—a testament to the quality of its services and facilities.

PALM BEACH PAR-3 GOLF COURSE*345 S Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach*

Widely recognized as Palm Beach’s best public course, Palm Beach Par-3 Golf Course offers 18 holes, a full-length driving range, putting green, and practice bunker. After a day on the green, enjoy chilled drinks and food at the outdoor restaurant and bar, Al Fresco.

PALM BEACH COUNTRY CLUB*760 N Ocean Blvd, Palm Beach*

Built on over a century of tradition and spanning 83 acres, Palm Beach Country Club offers a stunning championship golf course by the legendary architect Donald Ross, along with Har-Tru tennis courts, a swimming pool, and a fitness center.

THE BEACH CLUB*755 N County Rd, Palm Beach*

This premier private club is known for its outstanding recreational amenities, including one of the region’s finest heated saltwater pools, a state-of-the-art health club, lighted Har-Tru tennis courts, and croquet courts.

THE EVERGLADES CLUB*356 Worth Ave, Palm Beach*

Two of Palm Beach Island’s founding figures, legendary architect Addison Mizner and Paris Singer, an heir to the sewing machine fortune, opened The Everglades Club in 1919. Since then, it has lived on as one of the area’s most private and iconic social clubs.

THE OCEAN COURSE AT THE BREAKERS*One S County Rd, Palm Beach*

The Ocean Course at The Breakers is the oldest golf course in Florida. Designed by Alexander H. Findlay in 1897 and renovated in 2018 by golf course architect Rees Jones, this tropically landscaped course now has 56 sand- and grass-faced bunkers, six lakes, 6,500 square feet of putting green, and 18,000 square feet of practice green.

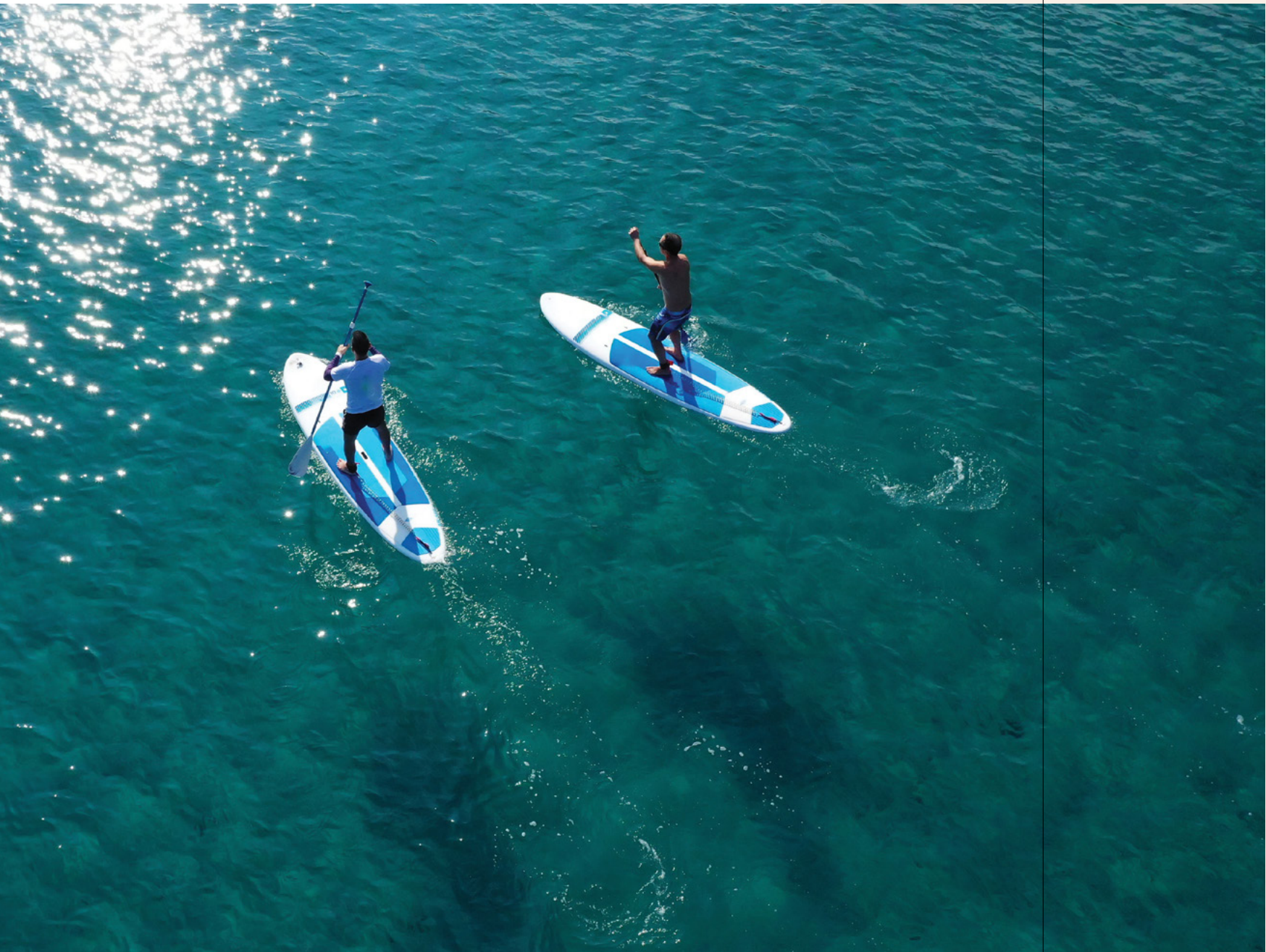




Water Sports & Activities

313 Worth Ave, Palm Beach

BiCE opened its first restaurant in Milan nearly 100 years ago, and today it has seven locations across the globe—including BiCE Ristorante Palm Beach. Set on Worth Avenue in an airy space with a dreamy courtyard, BiCE serves traditional Milanese dishes, including Veal Ossobuco and Cotoletta di Vitello, that transport you to Italy.

CAFÉ BOULUD

301 Australian Ave, Palm Beach

Café Boulud’s Palm Beach outpost in The Brazilian Court Hotel remains one of the area’s most coveted dining destinations. Credit the lush courtyard terrace and house specialties like the Dover Sole Meunière, which is filleted tableside.

CAFÉ L’EUROPE

331 S County Rd, Palm Beach

Café L’Europe is the place to dine on Royal Osetra caviar with blinis and Champagne while listening to Palm Beach’s favorite piano man, David Crohan.

FELICE

366 S Rosemary Ave, West Palm Beach

Felice opened its first restaurant outside of New York right here in The Square, in the heart of West Palm Beach. The menu is inspired by traditional Tuscan cuisine, with rustic dishes such as Pappardelle alla Salsiccia and Tagliata Di Manzo. Savor the taste of the restaurant’s house chardonnay, sangiovese, and rosato, which are produced at an organic vineyard in the Tuscan countryside.

FRENCH GRILL HOUSE

427 Northwood Rd, West Palm Beach

French Grill House is a casual restaurant serving up fresh seafood and meat in an expansive outdoor dining space. Fresh fish, steak, and chicken are spiced to perfection and prepared on a 12-foot grill and rotisserie. The seasonal cocktails here are the best way to end a day in the sun.

HENRY’S PALM BEACH

229 Royal Poinciana Way, Palm Beach

Nestled inside Palm Beach’s Via Flagler by The Breakers shopping center, Henry’s is a charming spot for lunch, dinner, and drinks. Delight in flavorful American comfort cuisine, including nostalgic dishes like Chicken Pot Pie and Butter Crumb Dover Sole, while sipping on a hand-crafted cocktail or glass of wine from a Master Sommelier-curated list.

IMOTO AT BUCCAN

350 S County Rd, Palm Beach

With his original Buccan, James Beard Award Nominee Clay Conley revolutionized Palm Beach dining with an informal ambiance and a dazzling selection of sophisticated small plates. But here’s a secret: we love Imoto, Buccan’s “little sister” next door, even more. Credit Conley’s inventive takes on sushi and sashimi, and a melt-in-your mouth wood-fired wagyu beef, inspired by his time cooking in Tokyo.

LA GOULUE

288 S County Rd, Palm Beach

The Upper East Side French bistro scene started with La Goulue—and it’s still where a certain strata of well-heeled New Yorkers holds court. In 2020, they found their new winter destination when a sister spot opened on Palm Beach’s best corner. Legendary dishes include the soupe à l’oignon gratinée, which takes three days of labor-intensive prep.

LE BILBOQUET

245a Worth Ave, Palm Beach

There’s nothing like Le Bilboquet’s energy. Maybe it’s the stunning location, or maybe it’s the always-delicious French dishes, like the Cajun chicken with beurre blanc sauce. Whatever the secret, we always know it’s going to be a good time when we head out to Bilbo, especially for its lively second seating.

PALM BEACH GRILL

340 Royal Poinciana Way #336, Palm Beach

Some regulars secure rolling reservations for the season, so if you want one of Palm Beach Grill’s hard-to-come-by booths, it pays to plan ahead—months ahead. Everyone’s favorite pairing is the Silver-Service Kosher Hot Dog (with deviled egg) and the island’s best martini.

PISTACHE

101 N Clematis St, West Palm Beach

The crimson banquettes and classic French dishes—think perfect steak frites, and moules marinières in a white wine-garlic broth—at Pistache always put us in a Parisian state of mind.

PIZZA AL FRESCO

14 Via Mizner, Palm Beach

Pizza Al Fresco’s wood-burning brick-oven pies are the best in town. Made with thin crust and fresh ingredients, they’re cooked to perfection every time. You’ll love dining in the restaurant’s courtyard, which is surrounded by stunning Palm Beach architecture.

MALAKOR THAI CAFE

425 25th St, West Palm Beach

Malakor Thai Cafe is a vibrant spot that stands out for its colorful Thai-inspired decor and flavorful food. The menu is extensive, with classic sweet, sour, and spicy dishes made using ingredients grown and sourced by the chef, plus a fresh sushi bar.

MEAT MARKET PALM BEACH

191 Bradley Pl, Palm Beach

Meat Market is one of Palm Beach’s top restaurants, offering an exceptional dining experience in a chic setting. Each of the many steak options on the menu is masterfully cooked to your preference and served with delightful sauces and butters. The seafood is equally great—always fresh and beautifully prepared.

RENATO’S

Renato’s Old-World feel can’t be beat, but what keeps us coming back is its spicy Spaghetini Fra Diavolo, prepared with thin house-made spaghetti and hearty chunks of Maine lobster.

RH ROOFTOP

Dining in Restoration Hardware’s olive tree-lined atrium is a glamorously surreal experience. But make no mistake—the expertly executed classics, including crispy artichoke with rosemary aioli, and top-of-the-line lobster roll with drawn butter and Old Bay, are worth the visit alone.

There’s no better place to tuck in after a shopping trip than Sant Ambroeus’ palm-tree-shaded courtyard. The Royal Poinciana Way restaurant offers all the same favorites as its Manhattan and Southampton locations, including the Vitello Tonnato and Tagliatelle alla Bolognese.

SPRUZZO AT THE BEN

West Palm Beach*

At this 360-degree rooftop bar atop The Ben, we’re not sure which is better—lounging in a private poolside cabana by day, or gathering around a warming firepit when the sun goes down. Whatever the choice, we know we’re in for delicious ricotta bites and lollipop lamb chops, tweaked classic cocktails, and sweeping views of the Palm Harbor Marina and Intracoastal.

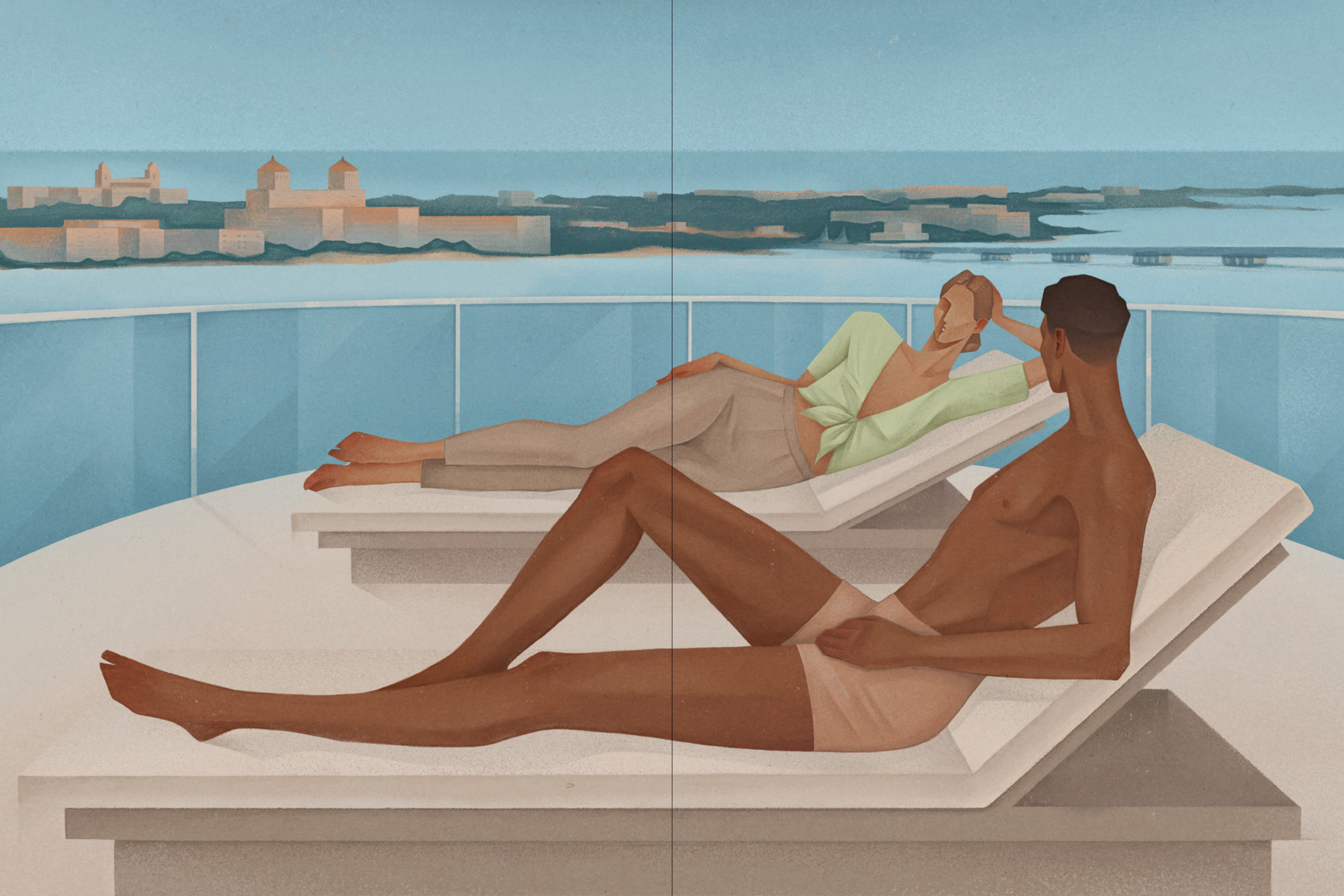
